## Methodology and Transparency

Sponsor(s)	This is a subscription-based poll where clients buy into the underlying survey and also add proprietary question(s). All survey questions were prepared by Data Orbital Consulting, LLC.
Target Population	Likely, general election voters in Arizona.
Sampling Frame & Methodology	Frame: The sample frame includes registered voters with either a landline telephone or mobile phone. Registered voters without access to either a landline telephone or a mobile phone are excluded from the frame.
	Methodology: Live caller survey; 70/30 landline telephone/mobile phone split.
	Contacted voters were selected randomly from a list of registered voters in Arizona purchased by Data Orbital Consulting, LLC from i360. Only voters determined likely to vote in the general election were selected to participate in the survey, based on past general election participation. Of the voters surveyed, 80% have voted in between two and four of the last four general elections, 10% have voted in one of the last four general elections, and 10% have voted in none of the last four general elections or are new voters who have registered to vote since 11/9/16. Voters without a valid landline telephone number were selected for the mobile sample.
	Selected voters were contacted from October 16-17, 2018 using live agents in a live caller, CATI survey presented in English.



## Weighting

The sample was weighted for gender, age, race and party affiliation and geographic region. Weighting benchmarks were determined using the past four general elections (2016, 2014, 2012 and 2010) with greater weight placed on the last two midterm elections. Election data was sourced from i360 and the Arizona Secretary of State.
